Subject: DISTRICT CENTRALIZED TRAINING IN JOURNALISM
"We Share What We Know, We Build What We Can, We Rise Together"

1. In pursuit of the Department of Education's continuing commitment to developing learners' skills and potentials in campus journalism, this district shall conduct a District Centralized Training in Journalism on September 26, 2026.
2. This activity is a collective effort to further strengthen the competencies, confidence, creativity, and competitive readiness of our young journalists in preparation for the upcoming journalism competitions at the EDDIS, Division, Regional and National Levels.
3. The initiative is particularly significant as the District has proudly maintained its standing as EDDIS Champion for three consecutive years. This remarkable achievement reflects the dedication and excellence of our learners, teacher-coaches, school heads, and the entire District. More importantly, it inspires us to continuously improve, remain resilient and prepare our young journalists to meet the demands of higher-level competition.
4. The training shall be facilitated by teacher-experts and potential resource speakers in their respective journalism categories, who are generously sharing their knowledge, experiences, strategies, and best practices with our learners and coaches.
5. Selected School Heads shall serve as monitors/supervisors to ensure the smooth, meaningful, and purposeful implementation of the activity and to provide the necessary support to the participants and trainers.
6. This training aims to
 - a. strengthen the technical and practical skills of learners in their respective journalism categories;
 - b. provide opportunities for learners to learn from experienced teacher-experts and practitioners;
 - c. enhance learners' confidence, creativity, critical thinking, and resilience in journalism competitions;
 - d. promote collaboration and sharing of expertise among schools, teachers, coaches and school heads
 - e. sustain the District's culture of excellence and competitiveness in journalism; and



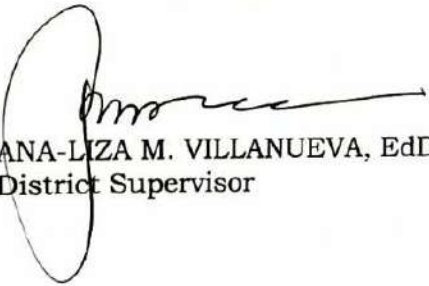
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- f. prepare learners to confidently represent the District in higher-level competitions, with the aspiration of reaching and succeeding at the National Schools Press Conference
7. The activity shall be participated in by the identified learner-participants/contestants and their teacher-coaches from the different schools in the District.
8. The district shall tap competent and experienced teacher-experts who have demonstrated expertise and potential in the different journalism categories. Their participation embodies the spirit of professional sharing, collaboration and collective growth, recognizing that excellence becomes more meaningful when knowledge and experience are generously shared with others.
9. Selected School Heads shall be designated as Monitors/Supervisors during the training. They shall help ensure the effective implementation of the activity, provide technical and administrative support when necessary, and document significant observations and recommendations for succeeding training activities.
10. All concerned are enjoined to extend their full support and active participation in this undertaking.
